

## General Information & Policies

All buses are accessible and the drivers will assist any customer who may need assistance getting on or off the bus.

Bus routes are subject to change due to various weather conditions, roadway construction or other possible unforeseen circumstances. In the event of inclement weather please call Transportation at (908) 231-7151 to find out if the bus is operating.

Please be considerate of other customers by observing the following rules:

- No smoking, drinking, eating or littering.
- Speak softly when using cell phones
- Use ear phones when listening to audio equipment.
- Foot ware and shirts are required

**Q. Who can use CAT?**

A. CAT is a public transit bus that anyone may use.

**Q. Is CAT accessible?**

A. Yes, all buses are equipped with a lift.

**Q. What if I'm ADA eligible?**

A. Customers must call 908-231-7151 at least 24-hours in advance for ADA eligible off route pickups.

**Q. What is Route Deviation?**

A. For ADA eligible customers bus will flex up to ¾ of a mile either side of fixed route.

**Q. How much does CAT cost?**

A. The fare is \$1.50 each way. Drivers cannot make change, so exact change is required in dollar bills or coins. Children age 5 and under accompanied by an adult ride free.

**Q. Why isn't my NJ TRANSIT pass accepted on CAT?**

A. CAT is not a NJ TRANSIT bus. It is operated by Somerset County.

**Q. Where do I call if I have questions about using CAT?**

A. Call Somerset County Transportation at 908-231-7151.

**Q. Where does CAT go?**

A. CAT follows a fixed route and schedule with ADA route deviation. The map on this schedule shows the towns and time points.

**Q. What if I want to ride to a location that is not along the route?**

A. The CAT buses can not deliver customers to a location that is not along the route. Customers must board or discharge at the stop nearest to your destination.

**Q. Does CAT operate on weekends or holidays?**

A. CAT operates Monday through Friday at the times listed on the schedule. CAT will not operate on the following holidays:
