**Treasurer report:** L. Monetti reported the Commission received a donation of \$100.00 from the Watchung PBA bringing the account balance to \$567.15.

**County Report:** C. Britt reported that the applications for the Annual Grant and the Competitive Grants are both due at noon on the 24<sup>th</sup> of May and that the quarterly reports were due April 1st. She mentioned two programs that were running, Essential Components of the IEP being held on North Bridge St., Somerville on April 9<sup>th</sup> and Transitioning from School to Adult Life being held in the Manville High School on April 25<sup>th</sup>. Both programs are free of charge.

**Input/Discussions:** M. Nunn advised the Commission that the school will not be utilizing the full amount of the annual grant for the two programs being run with grant money, “Girls on the run” and the “Pursuit of Excellence”. She asked C. Britt if the remainder of the funds could be used for a different program. C. Britt explained that the funds could be used for another program but not for a one day event. She explained that the program could piggyback off of an assembly or as a continuation of another program and could be carried over to September but that an explanation of what the leftover money was being used for would have to be submitted to county for their records.
