Correspondence: Quarterly Report

Treasurer report: There is a balance of \$67.15 in the Donation account.

The Quarterly report for the 2019-2020 school year has been updated to reflect all programs run in the school year. \$610.68 remains in the budget from the 2018 grant. The full amount of \$5,000. from the 2019 grant has not been utilized and if the county awards the grants to Watchung for the 2020 grant there will be a total of \$10,610.68 available to utilize for the 2020/21 School year for programs that would benefit at risk students.

Unfinished business: The former Commission members discussed changing the bi-laws, in Article IV under meetings, about changing the minimum amount of meetings to four (4) times per year or quarterly. Additional meeting can take place as needed. Bi-law changes can be made by the Commission's majority vote.
