#### **Am I Eligible?**

You may qualify for the Aging in Place program if you meet all of the following criteria:

- I own and live in my home full-time
- I am age 62 or older, or someone else who lives in my home full-time is age 62 or older
- My home is in Morris County, Middlesex County\*, or Greater Plainfield\*\* New Jersey
- The mortgage on my home is current, or there is no mortgage
- All taxes and homeowners' insurance are current
- I meet the income guidelines for my county

#### What Kind of Work is Eligible?

The work provided will be determined by Morris Habitat for Humanity after an inspection of the home.

Modifications to improve the mobility, accessibility and safety of your home or energy efficiency repairs and improvements, include:

- Installing wheelchair ramps
- Installing chair lifts on stairways

- Securing handrails and grab bars
- Changing faucets and door knobs to levers
- · Installing handheld and/or slidebar showerheads
- · Adding LED light fixtures to basement stairs
- Repairing sidewalks
- Other accessibility or weatherization improvements
